

KOREA-SINGAPORE ARRANGEMENT FOR THE CO-PRODUCTION OF BROADCASTING PROGRAMMES

The Korea-Singapore Arrangement for the Co-production of Broadcasting Programmes was signed between MDA and the former Korean Broadcasting Commission (KBC; now known as Korean Communications Commission (KCC), after its merger with the Ministry of Information & Communication (MIC) in February 2008) on 21 June 2007.

Under this Arrangement, Singapore producers or broadcasters can engage their Korean counterparts in the joint production of approved television programmes, including animation, dramas and documentaries. Such joint undertakings would be considered as national productions of the two countries, and qualify as local content and can apply for assistance schemes for co-productions, where applicable.

The Arrangement and is administered by MDA's International Relations team, together with the Korean Communications Commission.
